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Programs and Services

Amazing Explorers Academy Citrus Park provides care and educational programming for children from 6 weeks through 12 years of age. Our offerings include:

- **Early Childhood Programs:** Infant, toddler, preschool, and pre-kindergarten care and education.
- **Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK):** A state-supported early learning program designed to help prepare eligible four-year-old children for kindergarten.
- **Private Kindergarten:** A full kindergarten program led by a qualified kindergarten teacher and designed to support academic, social, and developmental growth.
- **After-School Program:** School-age care and enrichment for eligible children through age 12.
- **STEAM-Based Learning:** Hands-on learning experiences that integrate science, technology, engineering, the arts, and mathematics throughout the curriculum.
- **Enrichment Opportunities:** Offerings may include STEAM Sports, STEAM Cuisine, and programs provided by approved outside vendors. Availability may vary based on scheduling, enrollment, and vendor participation.

Classroom Teacher Qualifications

- **Early Childhood and VPK Classrooms:** Teachers meet applicable Florida Department of Children and Families training requirements. At a minimum, classroom teachers complete the required 45 hours of child care training. Most lead teachers also hold a Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential or another applicable early childhood credential.
- **Private Kindergarten:** The kindergarten teacher holds the teaching certificate required to teach kindergarten.
